Career description:

Instructs student in cosmetology programs in shampooing, cutting, coloring, and styling patron's hair. They also provide instruction in massage, facials, and scalp treatments and the application of make-up. They also teach students to perform hair removal and to provide nail and skin care services. Analyzes patron's hair and other physical features to determine and recommend beauty treatment.
